RANDY

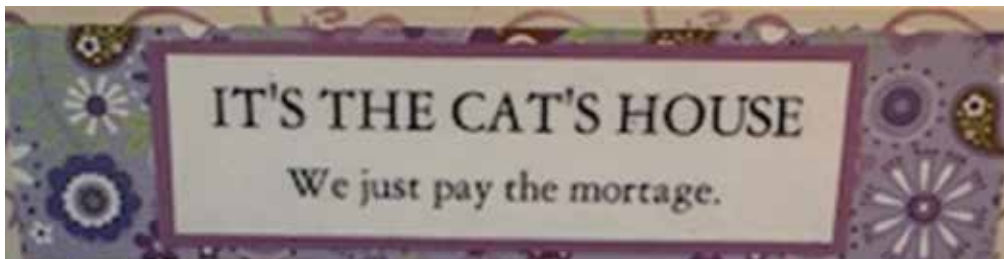

SLOE AND MOE

Meet Sloe and Moe. They would introduce themselves, but their verbalization is limited to glub, glub, glub. They are four (4) year old goldfish that were no bigger than your pinky finger nail when they moved in. Sloe is the fancier tailed fish whereas Moe is chunkier and more robust.

Each day is happily greeted with wagging tails and flipping fins. When the fish tank light glows they vigorously swim to the surface for their daily portion of vitamin enriched flakes. As the flakes sink to the bottom, Moe dives deep and artfully moves the stones to reach every little morsel of food while Sloe floats mid-tank to retrieve whatever rises up from Moe's scavenging. Their team work is incredible.

Once in a while Sloe will top swim and spout a stream of water past the surface just like a statue in a fountain. And, as daylight wains they go into relax mode, slowing down, maintaining neutral buoyancy.

The best part of having these shimmering beauties is the low maintenance. No walking, no picking up after them, no shedding, no grooming, no toys, no allergic reaction, no vet bills. The small filter in their 3.5 gallon tank is changed every two (2) weeks, the tank cleaned once a month. Other than the filter there is a bubbler to keep the right amount of air in the water and a thermometer to keep the environment around 70°. Feeding is once a day with a container of flakes lasting months.

Did you know fish tanks can help reduce anxiety and stress. Studies show that watching fish swim can lower heart rate and reduce stress hormones, leading to a sense of calm and relaxation. These pets are quite entertaining and I find myself gazing at them and not the television.

Welcome July!

As we enter this busy time of summer, please take a moment to read our helpful safety hints.

Car Accident Tips: If you get into an auto accident, follow these steps:

1. Check yourself and passengers for injuries - if unsure- call 911 and let the experts make the determination.
2. If vehicle is driveable, try and move it to side of road to avoid getting hit again and put on flashers. If it ISN'T driveable but you are unhurt, leave vehicle and go to side of road.
3. Await help.
4. Exchange insurance information if minor fender-bender, otherwise get police report when completed. Taking photos of vehicles can be a help to your insurance as well.
5. Notify your insurance company as soon as possible.

Pool/Beach Safety

1. **NEVER** swim alone!!!
2. Obey all rules posted, especially beach flags warning of dangerous riptides.
3. If with children, make sure to **NEVER** let them out of your sight. It takes just a few seconds to get knocked down by a wave or slip into the deep end. **PUT YOUR PHONE DOWN!**
4. If you hear thunder, get out of the water immediately because lightning strikes can be deadly!

Fireworks/Grill Safety

1. Follow instructions on fireworks and make sure the area is clear.
 2. Wear goggles.
 3. **NEVER** relight a "dud"
 4. Make sure grill is clean and greasefree
 5. Grills should be at LEAST 10 feet away from house
 6. **NEVER** leave grill unattended

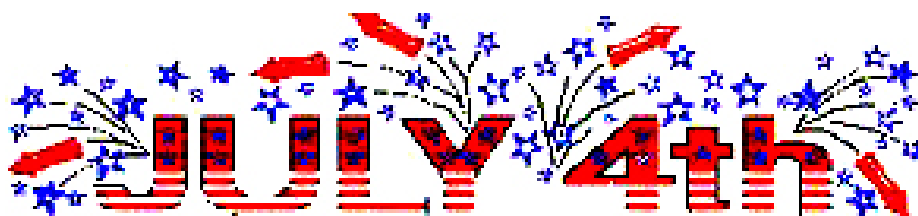
PORK CHOPS - Mushroom Sauce

Ingredients:

- 2lbs. boneless chops
- 2 tsps. olive oil
- 2 tsps. butter
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 cup sliced onion
- 1 tsp. minced garlic
- 1 cup white wine
- 1/2 cup unsalted chicken stock or water
- 1 can 10.5oz. condensed cream of mushroom soup

Directions:

1. Pat dry the chops, season with salt & pepper.
2. In a deep pan with a lid, heat oil and butter together.
3. Add chops and sear 3-5 min. each side. Remove chops, set aside.
4. Add celery, onion, and garlic to pan. Saute til soft.
5. Add wine and soup, stir well til incorporated.
6. Put pork chops back in pan, cover & cook for 15 minutes.
7. Garnish with parsley and a squeeze of lemon.



HASH BROWN POTATO CASSEROLE

Ingredients:

- 1 pkg. hash brown potatoes (30 oz.)
- 1 small onion
- 2 cans of condensed cream of mushroom or potato soup
- 16 oz. sour cream
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 400°.
2. Spray a 13 x 9 x 2-inch baking dish with vegetable cooking spray.
3. In a large bowl, stir the hash brown potatoes, onion, soup, and sour cream and 1/2 the cheddar cheese and grated parmesan cheese. Season with salt & pepper.
4. Spread the potato mixture in the prepared baking dish and cover. Bake for 30 minutes.
5. Uncover and sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake for another 30 minutes.

SPAGHETTI CARBONARA - 1 POT

Ingredients:

- 4 slices of bacon
- 1 small, chopped onion
- 1 can (10.5 oz.) condensed cream of chicken soup
- 3 1/2 cups of chicken broth
- 1/2 cup grated Romano or Parmesan cheese
- 8 oz uncooked spaghetti
- 1 cup frozen peas

Directions:

1. Cook bacon in a 6 qt. sauce pot or Dutch oven.
2. Crisp the bacon and drain on paper towel.
3. Leave some drippings in the pan.
4. Stir in the broth, soup and cheese. Bring to a boil.
5. Reduce the heat to medium and add spaghetti. Cook to "al dente". Stir in peas. Crumble the bacon on top before serving.

KIRMS PHOTOGRAPHY

It's summer time and a great time to get some shots at the beach and pool. On crowded beaches you can shoot the people, activities, and colorful umbrellas. On remote beaches you can look for wildlife, patterns in the sand, or great cloud formations against the water. There's always sunrise images early in the morning. Don't forget sunscreen and a hat!

The challenge with beach shots is getting the proper exposure. Your camera is designed to give you an average exposure of the entire scene. This is why most of your images are properly exposed. A very bright scene tricks your camera into thinking there is too much light, so the camera will cut back on exposure. To compensate you should increase the exposure slightly. If your camera has "scene" modes, use the one for snow or beach.

A great way to enhance your images is using a polarizing filter, which cuts glare the same as polarizing sunglasses. Many photographers use this filter to make the sky in their images darker (and the clouds brighter) but this filter works wonderfully to show the detail in the sand and to remove the reflections in the water. This also works well for images around the pool.
