

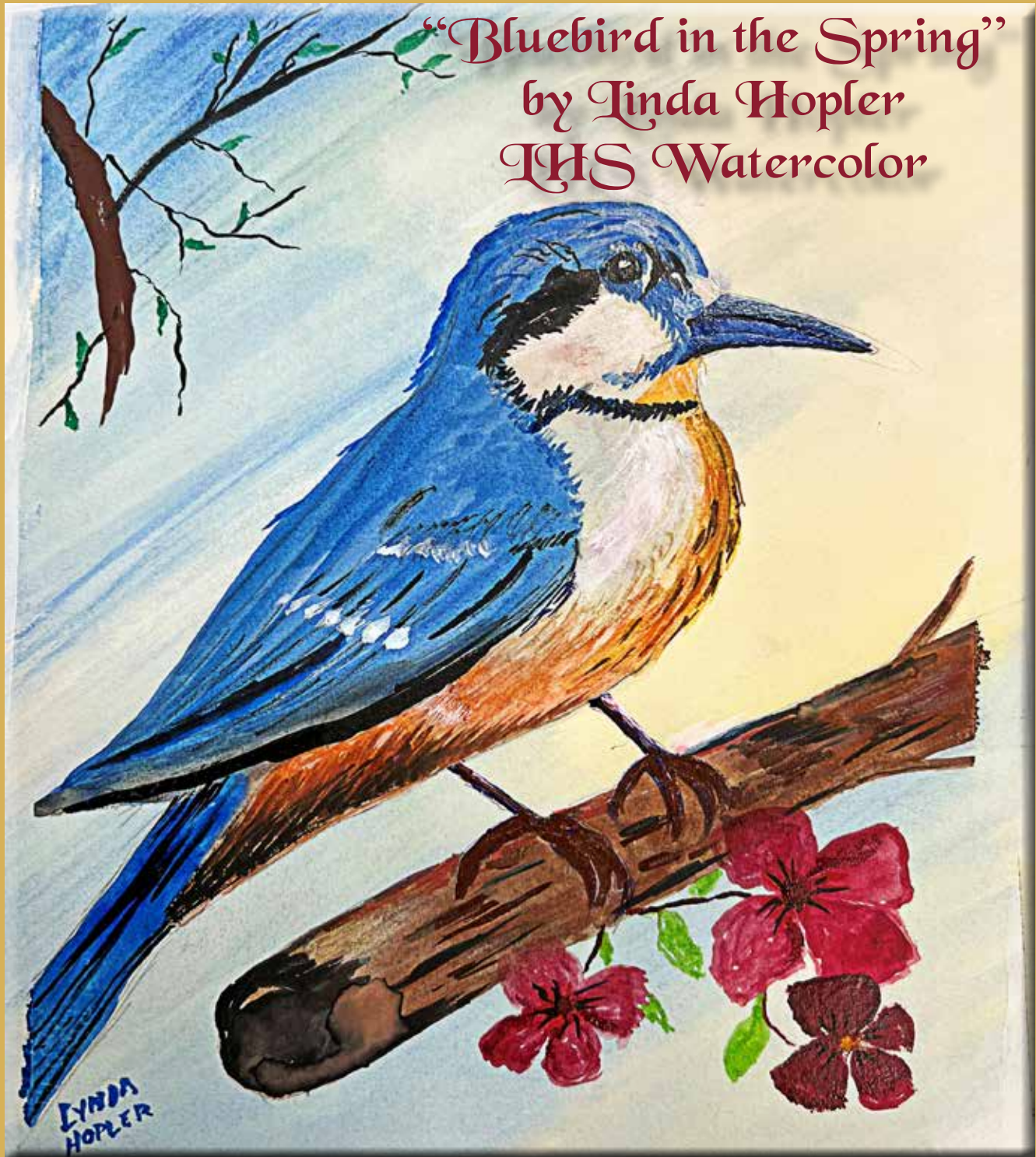

As a reminder, all residents are enthusiastically invited to take advantage of the large and varied selection of hard-cover and paperback books, condensed books, large print books, cookbooks, audio books, movie DVD's, periodicals, magazines and jigsaw puzzles offered in our clubhouse library. 1. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY** Swim at your own risk.
 2. All members/residents and guests must sign-in upon entrance to the pool area.
 3. **THUNDER AND LIGHTNING:** When thunder occurs, all individuals must leave the pool area. The pool area will be reopened when conditions permit.
 4. **FOR SAFETY REASONS** – Pool furniture must be kept at least six (6) feet from the edge of the pool.
 5. Restrooms shall not be used as changing rooms. Dripping bathing suits and bare feet are not allowed in the clubhouse and restroom.
 6. At all times members/residents and/or guests 16 or over must display numbered plastic badges for admission to the pool area.
 7. Children 15 or under must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult and must be signed in. No child aged 2-15 will be allowed in the pool between 1pm and 5pm except on Saturdays, when they are allowed in the pool from 12pm – 5pm. Children under the age of 2 are not allowed in the pool at any time. Diapers are not permitted at any age.
 8. Bathers must wear suitable bathing suits or swim wear. Cut-off pants or jeans are not permitted in the pool.
 9. Flotation objects, such as inflatable tubes, kickboards, and flippers, are not permitted in the pool. Styrofoam belts and arm “swimmies” will be permitted in the pool when an adult is in the pool with the child.
 10. Diving is not permitted at any time.
 11. Jumping is not permitted at any time.
 12. Snacks, plastic bottles and cans are permitted inside the pool area and must be consumed at a table. **NO GLASS OR ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED.** Picnic tables are available outside the pool area for those having sandwiches, subs, pizza, etc.

A charcoal grill is available for your use outside the pool area. A fire shovel and ash can are also provided. Please clean up after use.

Garbage and recyclables must be disposed of in the receptacles that are provided outside of the pool entrance.
 13. No sports, including ball playing or horseplay, will be permitted in the pool area. Children may have dive toys in the shallow end of the pool. Running is not permitted in the pool area. Loud music is not permitted.
 14. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool enclosure. (N.J.A.C.8:26)
 15. Smoking and “vaping” is permitted only at the end of the sidewalk in the parking area. Smoking and “vaping” are not permitted near the pool area or in any other sports area.
 16. Chairs, tables and lounges are available to residents on first come basis. **THEY MAY NOT BE RESERVED.** Please bring chairs for your guests.
 17. Upon exiting the pool area, please return chairs and lounges to their regular locations. Umbrellas are to be rolled down and tied.
 18. Our pool maintenance company is Specialized Pools.

Welcome Spring!

With the warm weather upon us and spring break coming up - everyone is coming out of hibernation. Let's make pedestrian and traffic safety a priority here at LHS.

Many residents use walkers and wheelchairs and want to head outdoors to enjoy the warmer weather - we need to be on the lookout for them. With spring holidays, family and other visitors usually increase, so be aware of strollers and our many dog walkers, especially at crosswalks and in the evenings.

Brick Traffic Safety officers have evaluated our community numerous times using varied methods. At this time, we don't meet the criteria for speed bumps, flashing stop signs or additional lines at other crosswalks. The traffic study that was conducted showed the *average* speed to be 33 MPH. While residents can debate this issue - that was the result of the study.

Going forward, the security committee would like to be the first line of communication for speeding and security issues and/or questions before calling Brick Traffic Safety office. If residents could send an email to staff@lionshead-south.com with **SECURITY** in the subject line (they will be forwarded to our committee chair) it will allow us to address concerns, answer questions and track trends to determine what, if any, action needs to be initiated. It also frees up the Traffic Safety officers to try and keep the rest of Brick roads safe.

Freaky Friday Block Party June 13

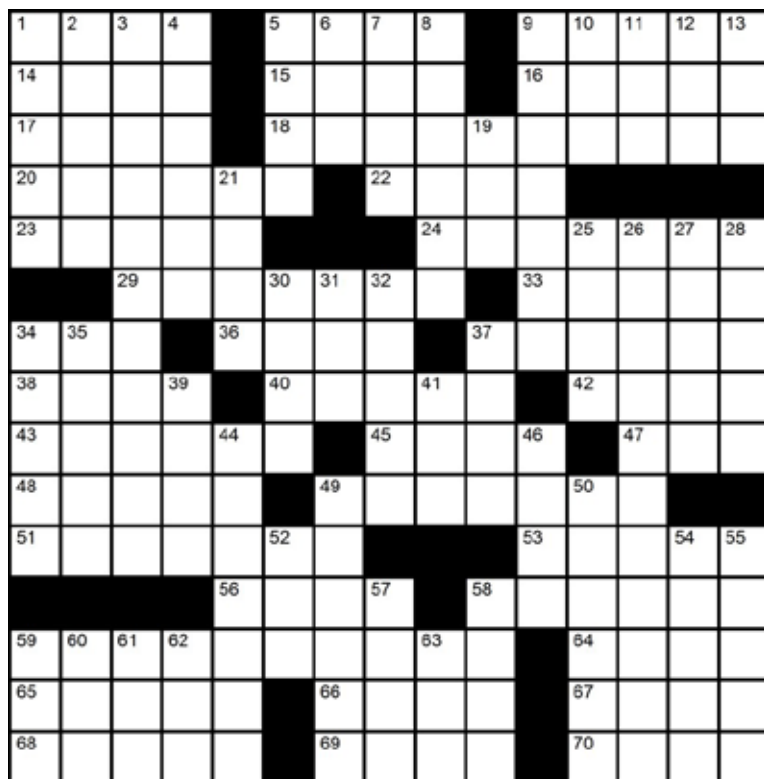

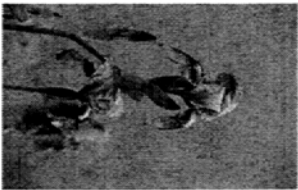

SUMMER APPROACHING...and some of the BEST produce in the world is found in N.J. A bite of a Jersey tomato, or an ear of sweet corn and a handful of blueberries....you know why it's called "THE GARDEN STATE"!

Quoted from Bergenfield's original Pete Napolitano, ...also known as "PRODUCE PETE". You may have viewed PETE on Saturday mornings channel 4... "WEEK-END - TODAY in NY" TV show. If you have a moment to spare, read Pete's very interesting story online and why he knows New Jersey's fruits & vegetables are the best! Below are three of Pete's favorite recipes:

ESCAROLE AND BEANS

Ingredients:

2 heads escarole
1/4 cup of olive oil
4 cloves garlic chopped
1/2 tsp hot & crushed RED pepper
Salt & pepper to taste

Directions:

1. Cut bottom core of escarole, slice into small pieces & soak & rinse very well.
2. In a large pot bring 4 cups of water to a boil.
3. Place escarole pieces in steamed water until tender, drain into colander and set side.
4. In the same large pot, add olive oil & garlic. Sauté until golden brown.
5. Add escarole to pot and remaining ingredients. Stir to combine and heat thoroughly.
6. Salt & pepper taste.

OPTIONAL: ADD with direction #5. A drained CAN OF CANNELONI BEANS to heat with escarole.

BROCCOLI SALAD

Ingredients:

2 Heads of broccoli washed & cut into small pieces
1/2 cup Golden raisins or dried cranberries
1 small red (or white) onion diced
1/2 lb. bacon cooked crispy & chopped
3/4 cup cashew nuts
Dressing:

Whisk together 1-1/4 cup of mayonnaise, 3-4 tsp. of red wine or balsamic vinegar & 1/3 cup sugar.

Directions:

1. In a large bowl, mix all ingredients.
2. Stir & mix well.
3. Chill & serve.

NECTARINE SURPRISE

Ingredients:

2 med nectarines peeled & pitted
1 peeled banana
4-5 strawberries
1/2 cup of orange juice
1/2 cup of pineapple juice
1 tsp honey
4 ice cubes

Directions:

1. Cut fruit into chunks, place in blender and add remaining ingredients.
2. Blend at a low speed for 30 seconds.
3. Blend on high for 15 seconds.
4. Fill each serving glass with blended fruits & garnish with mint & pineapple slices.
