

The warmer weather is upon us. Please take time to inspect the outside of your home. The Spring walkthroughs will start in June.



Let's keep our community looking beautiful!!!!!


#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Hello, LHS Friends and Neighbors.

On the sofa table adjacent to the large library table in the clubhouse hopefully you have already seen the "New Arrivals" book selection there. This area has been set up to call attention to recent donations you may have miss if library staff were to immediately mix these donations into the surrounding library shelves.

Temporarily placing these 'new arrivals' in this separate location gives everyone an opportunity to see donations as soon as they become available. These books (& sometimes movie DVD's & audio books) will stay in this section for a few weeks before they are finally placed in their corresponding areas on the wall shelves. So, when you are looking to make a library selection, we invite you to check out this 'new arrivals' section first to take advantage of recently donated items.

As a reminder, all residents are enthusiastically invited to take advantage of the large and varied selection of hardcover and paperback books, condensed books, large print books, cookbooks, audio books, movie DVD's, periodicals, magazines and jigsaw puzzles offered in our clubhouse library. There is never a need to sign anything out and no time limit imposed on their use. Of course, returning things in a timely manner is always appreciated to allow for other's enjoyment of these items.

The Lions Head South Library is also very willing and grateful to accept donations. Due to our limited space, we can only accept books whose copyright dates fall within the current 10-year period. In other words, please check the first few pages of your donations prior to drop off and only give us those books whose copyright date falls between 2015 through 2025 (except for cookbooks, biographies, non-fiction & especially large print books, which are all accepted with any copyright date). All types of jigsaw puzzles are also appreciated except those missing any pieces. Placing jigsaw puzzle pieces in a ziplock bag within their box prior to donating will help keep all the pieces secure. In the case of a large donation, please leave items in a bag or box on the floor under the library windows.

#### 2025 POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY Swim at your own risk.
- 2. All members/residents and guests must sign-in upon entrance to the pool area.
- THUNDER AND LIGHTNING: When thunder occurs, all individuals must leave the pool area. The pool area will be reopened when conditions permit.
- FOR SAFETY REASONS Pool furniture must be kept at least six (6) feet from the edge of the pool.
- 5. Restrooms shall not be used as changing rooms. Dripping bathing suits and bare feet are not allowed in the clubhouse and restroom.
- 6. At all times members/residents and/or guests 16 or over must display numbered plastic badges for admission to the pool area.
- Children 15 or under must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult and must be signed in. No child aged 2-15 will be allowed in the pool between 1pm and 5pm except on Saturdays, when they are allowed in the pool from 12pm – 5pm. Children under the age of 2 are not allowed in the pool at any time. Diapers are not permitted at any age.
- 8. Bathers must wear suitable bathing suits or swim wear. Cut-off pants or jeans are not permitted in the pool.
- 9. Flotation objects, such as inflatable tubes, kickboards, and flippers, arenot permitted in the pool. Styrofoam belts and arm "swimmies" will be permitted in the pool when an adult is in the pool with the child.
- Diving is not permitted at any time.
- 11. Jumping is not permitted at any time.

12. Snacks, plastic bottles and cans are permitted inside the pool area and must be consumed at a table. NO GLASS OR ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED. Picnic tables are available outside the pool area for those having sandwiches, subs, pizza, etc.

A charcoal grill is available for your use outside the pool area. A fire shovel and ash can are also provided. Please clean up after use.

Garbage and recyclables must be disposed of in the receptacles that are provided outside of the pool entrance.

- 13. No sports, including ball playing or horseplay, will be permitted in the pool area. Children may have dive toys in the shallow end of the pool. Running is not permitted in the pool area. Loud music is not permitted.
- 14. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool enclosure. (N.J.A.C.8:26)
- 15. Smoking and "vaping" is permitted only at the end of the sidewalk in the parking area. Smoking and "vaping" are not permitted near the pool area or in any other sports area.
- Chairs, tables and lounges are available to residents on first come basis. THEY MAY NOT BE RESERVED. Please bring chairs for your guests.
- 17. Upon exiting the pool area, please return chairs and lounges to their regular locations. Umbrellas are to be rolled down and tied.
- 18. Our pool maintenance company is Specialized Pools.



If you have a moment to spare, read Pete's very interesting story online and why he knows New Jersey's fruits & vegetables are the best! Below are three of Pete's favorite recipes:

#### **ESCAROLE AND BEANS**

#### **Ingredients:**

2 heads escarole
1/4 cup of olive oil
4 cloves garlic chopped
1/2 tsp hot & crushed RED pepper
Salt & pepper to taste

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Cut bottom core of escarole, slice into small pieces & soak & rinse very well.
  - 2. In a large pot bring 4 cups of water to a boil.
- 3. Place escarole pieces in steamed water until tender, drain into colander and set side.
- 4. In the same large pot, add olive oil & garlic. Sauté until golden brown.
- 5. Add escarole to pot and remaining ingredients. Stir to combine and heat thoroughly.
  - 6. Salt & pepper taste.

OPTIONAL: ADD with direction #5. A drained CAN OF CANNELONI BEANS to heat with escarole.

1 small red (or white) onion diced

1/2 lb. bacon cooked crispy & chopped

Whisk together 1-1/4 cup of mayonnaise, 3-4 tsp. of red wine or balsamic vinegar & 1/3 cup sugar.

- 1. In a large bowl, mix all ingredients.
- 2. Stir & mix well.
- 3. Chill & serve.


